How does our everyday life matter if God alone is holy?

I. God makes us holy - Colossians 1:15-23 (key verse 22)  
This Scripture shares how holy, set apart He is... and how he has made us holy, set apart with Him when we put our trust in what He has done for us on the cross.

II. God gives us the Holy Spirit to lead, empower, help us
